Title: **C1 A17: Government's proposal for Organic Regulation 2024/XX defining European citizenship, also called "The European Citizenship Charta"**

From line 163 to 166:

~~II. The request is not to be granted if the person has committed a crime in a Member States with a minimum sentence of one year in prison or if sincere and legitimate security concerns are being expressed by the state the person was living prior to the request.~~

II. The request shall be denied, if the individual has committed a crime covered by the four Geneva Conventions, or if the individual has committed a crime that carries a minimum sentence of 1 year in accordance with the EFL, within the last 5 years, or has committed a crime that carries a sentence of more than 12 years. III. The responsible authority can refuse the granting of citizenship in individual cases, only if a criminal record states that this individual has committed a crime violating the physical integrity of others.
